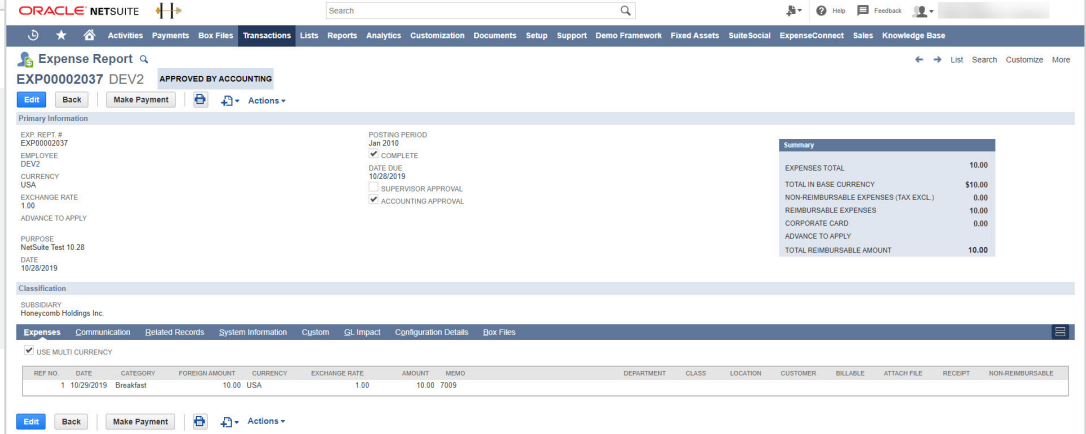
You can easily configure data mapping between Concur Expense and NetSuite.
